What to Expect: Service and Committal in the Garden

On the day of the service, the pastor will meet with the family in the Dickinson Room about 10 minutes before the service.

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He'll lead them in a short prayer, and then escort them to the sanctuary (or chapel). The family will be seated in reserved seating area. After the service, if the ashes are to be interred in the Memorial Garden at North, the family will follow the pastor out through the south wing exit.

Funeral or memorial services will follow the guidelines of the Directory for the Worship of God of the Presbyterian Church (USA). In all cases, the ashes will be interred as provided for in the Directory of Worship if the family has made prior arrangements with the

The Service

Each service is similar yet unique. You are able to pick hymns (see Music for the Service in this brochure), who speaks, and scriptures. These readings may be done by the minister or by readers chosen by the family. Typically families choose one reading from the Old Testament and one from the New Testament. Below are some recommendations to guide you:

Old Testament: Job 19:23-27; Ecclesiastes 3:1-15; Isaiah 40:1-11; Isaiah 40:28-31; Isaiah 65:17-25; Psalm 23; Psalm 46:1-5, 10-11; Psalm 90:1-10, 12; Psalm 103; Psalm 121; or Psalm 139:1-12.

New Testament: Romans 8:14-23, 31-39; Romans 14:7-9, 10b-12; 1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 35-38, 42-44, 50, 53-58; 2 Corinthians 4:16-5:1; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Revelation 21:1-4, 22-25; 22:3-5; Matthew 18:1-5, 10; Mark 10:13-16; Luke 23:33, 39-43; John 11:17-27; and John 14:1-6, 25-27.

Sharing Memories

During the service there is an opportunity for a family member or friend to share a reflection (usually following the meditation) about the deceased. Generally not more than two people should speak. Each person should plan on speaking for five minutes or less about the life and legacy of the deceased.
